FR. EMMANUEL KATABAAZI**MISSIONARY SPEAKER****Weekend of June 12th and 13th**

Immaculate Conception Parish is very pleased to welcome **Fr. Emmanuel Katabaazi from the Diocese of Masaka, in Uganda, East Africa** to speak at all Masses next weekend. Father Katabaazi was a Pastor for eight years at the Church of the Visitation and grew aware of the many medical needs of his people. He began efforts to assist his parishioners with their healthcare and was able to build and open two clinic operations within the parish boundaries. Each clinic operation served an average of eighty people per day.

His Bishop was so impressed by his efforts that while still Pastor, he was appointed the first Director of Catholic Health Care Systems for the Diocese. His Ministry currently is as the full time Coordinator of the Catholic Health Care Systems for the Diocese of Masaka and he oversees and advocates assistance for two hospitals and twenty-nine health care clinic outposts within the Diocesan boundaries taking care of hundreds of people per day.

Fr. Emmanuel is very dedicated to his ministry and is confident that God, through the efforts of this year's mission appeal in the Buffalo Diocesan family, will continue to bless this vital ministry within Masaka Diocese.

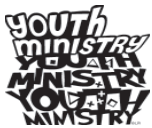

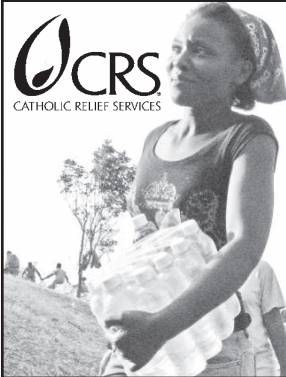
